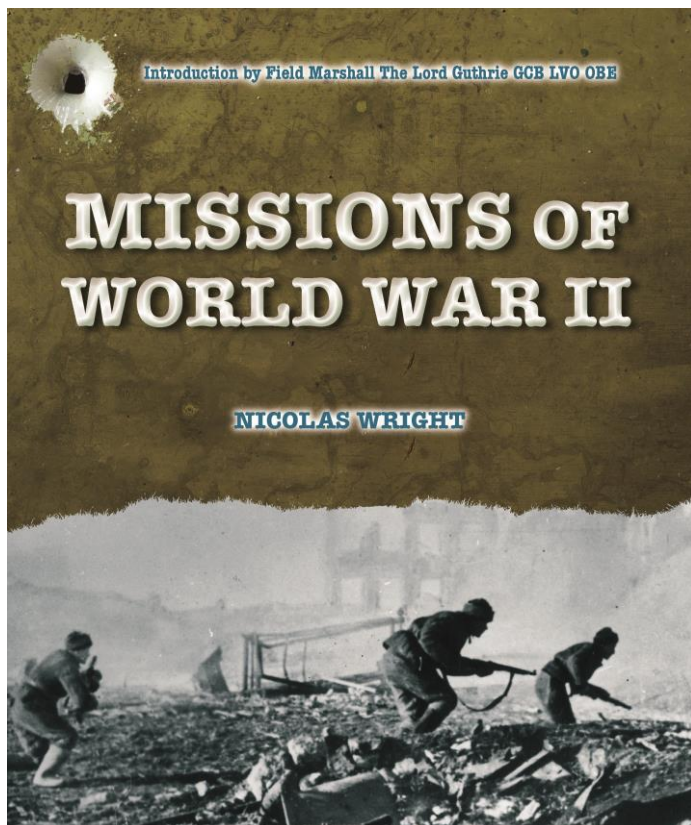

There were many campaigns and missions conducted by both sides through World War II. *Missions of World War II* takes a look at those that were the most daring or had the greatest effect on the outcome of the war.

Campaigns: The U-boat war; Desert war; Invasion of Poland; Germany's Blitzkrieg; Invasion of Holland and France; Invasion of Norway; The battle for Moscow; Pearl Harbor; 1000 bomber raid; Battle of Midway; Drive to Rome; Fall of Singapore; Fall of the Philippines; The Burma campaign; Battle of the Bulge; Battle for Iwo Jima; Fire raids on Japan; Battle of Stalingrad; War in the Pacific; Battle of Berlin.
