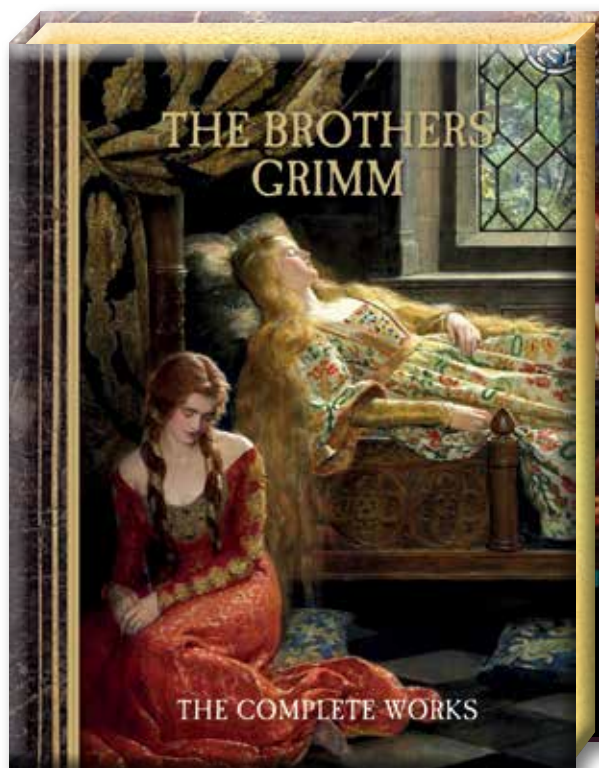


# The Brothers Grimm

## *The Complete Works*



Here is an amazing collection of the best-loved fairy stories in the world, gathered by linguists and literary scholars, Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm – born just over a year apart in the 1780s in Hanau, Germany. The culmination of their intensive research – after many years of recording and writing – was first published in 1812 as *Children's and Household Tales*, translating oral tradition into a literary masterpiece. For the next forty years or so, the collection was revised and augmented. It was republished many times and continues to be so today, sharing such stalwarts as *Cinderella*, *Hansel and Gretel*, *Rapunzel*, *Sleeping Beauty* and *Snow White*. This book (with illustrations by renowned artists Arthur Rackham and Walter Crane) covers the brother's entire and very impressive output of over 270 tales. Presenting many stories rarely included and some of the earliest versions, our impressive volume will appeal to children, parents and fairy tale enthusiasts from every sphere, including the academic world.
